



How Palama Settlement is Being COVID-19 Safe

1. Daily temperature checks of staff, students, vendors, and guests who enter campus. Those with temperature of 99°F or higher will not be able to enter and will be asked to leave. Parents will be notified.
2. Daily staff, student, and visitor logs for contact tracing use.
3. The use of masks is required for all staff and students, and anyone entering the Palama campus. Students must provide their own masks daily.
4. Parents will be notified to pick up their child if the child develops flu-like symptoms during the day.
5. Students will be kept in cohorts and not intermingle with other cohorts. Staff and instructors will stay with the same cohort of students throughout the day.
6. High touch points (door handles, light switches, computer keyboards, desks, etc.) will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day.
7. Social distancing of at least six feet will be maintained, and face coverings/masks worn at all times.
8. Frequent breaks for handwashing, especially after activities that involve touching supplies. Outdoor breaks will allow students to remove their face coverings (while maintaining social distancing) for a short period of time.
9. All public water fountains on campus are closed. Students are asked to bring their own water bottles or drinks.
10. Students must bring their own school supplies, i.e., pencils, pens, paper and/or notebooks. Students must supply their own headphones (in-ear, over-the ear, etc.)
11. *Lunches currently (as of 10/20/2020) being supplied by DOE's grab and go lunch program. Student should bring his school ID in the event that the school requires it for lunch pick up.
